As a YCC Ambassador, you will build awareness and engage young caregivers in an online community on the <u>Young Caregivers Connect</u> website as they navigate their caregiving journey. Ambassador's responsibilities include, but not limited to:

- Share caregiving experiences with others on the YCC online forum
- Connect young caregivers with others in similar and dissimilar caregiver experiences
- Help promote the YCC website with relevant networks and channels
- Provide feedback on OCO's programs and services

We are looking for young caregivers (aged 15 to 25) who are currently or have previously provided physical and/or emotional support to a family member or friend. You can use your personal caregiving experience to support other young caregivers, and gain training and volunteer experience working with an online community.

We ask all interested candidates to commit to the role for a minimum of 6 months. Selected ambassadors will be participating and contributing 2-3 posts per month and responsible for checking the discussion forum on a weekly basis. As part of our screening, YCC Ambassadors are required to complete a reference check and a Criminal Records Check. Volunteers under 18 years of age must provide parent/guardian's permission.
